

# Shipping In to Larkin Hill

Welcome!

We are happy you have joined us for a Larkin Hill function!

*While you are here, we ask that you please observe the following policies:*

1. Use the Main Driveway for Clinics and XC Schooling – 515 Country Rt. 32, North Chatham, NOT the Woodward Rd. entrance used for the horse trials.
2. Stay to the right going around the barn and park behind the barn. If you need to work out of the right side of your trailer, please pull up along the left side of the drive in order to keep HORSES OFF THE GRASS. If you have to park on the right, please do your best to keep horses off the grass while you get ready.
3. No vehicles parked on the grass (hot exhaust systems burn holes in the grass and create dead spots). Park all cars in the front of the barn.
4. There will be a hose available outside for washing/water. Please do not wash horses on the lawn...it creates mud holes. Please wash on the driveway.
5. Clean up any manure/shavings/hay before you leave. Dump manure and hay in the big compost/manure box that is next to the barn.
6. If you want to graze your horse, please go out next to the first grass paddock opposite the outdoor arena or along the treeline opposite the jumping area. No grazing on any grass attached to any building.
7. We are trying to heal the ground in the Jumping Field where we always have Stadium...it is marked with white stakes. Absolutely NO RIDING anywhere inside those white stakes.

*If you are riding in the Indoor:*

1. Be mindful that the grooming stalls are there first for the boarders. Please ask if you may use one, and if you do, be aware of how long you are in there and if anyone from the barn may need it. Also, make sure your things are out of the way of anyone coming in to use that stall while you are riding.
2. Any manure dropped is to be picked up immediately...not “later”.
3. If you use a grooming stall please make sure it is swept clean before you take your horse out so it is clean for the next person.
4. Please use the outside hose to wash, on the driveway as explained above.
5. Please pick footing from your horse’s feet before leaving arena.

I know it all sounds terribly fussy, but we are just trying to keep the place looking neat and tidy.
